

Emergency Kit Checklist

In this day and age with all the natural disasters and threat of disasters, it never hurts to be prepared. Here is a list of things to keep on hand in an emergency kit. Hopefully you'll never need it, but if you do, you'll be so glad you took to time to gather these items beforehand.

- Storage container or backpack
- Flashlight & batteries (or solar powered flashlight)
- Candles & waterproof matches
- Bottled water*
- Food
 - Canned goods*, can opener & plastic utensils
 - Energy bars*
 - Dried fruit*
 - Beef jerky*
- Radio (battery operated & water resistant) & batteries
- Facial tissues
- Blankets
- Alcohol wipes
- First aid kit
- Respiratory mask
- Emergency whistle
- Duct tape
- Pocket knife
- Wrench (to shut off gas)
- 1 pair work gloves
- Reading glasses
- Fireproof safe or key to safe deposit box (with important documents)

Note: Do not put prescription medications in your emergency kit, as these can expire or your doctor may change your prescription. Keep all prescription medications in one place, so that in case of an emergency you can find them all quickly.

*Be sure to check for any expiration dates & plan to replace those items before they expire.
